Curbstops were fixed for Sunrise Ln and Pat O'Brian.


Sewer cleanouts were fixed for Bub Eldredge and Brian Boya.

During the month of November Parks and recreation Dept performed the following duties.

Shoveled and salted all town walks as needed.

Cleaned and restocked the BlueMountain restroom and did garbage runs for the mini park ,BlueMountain ,Byron Park and the shop.

We had one burial this month at the Benton cemetery ,we dug the grave prepped and covered after the service.

We cut all of our snowmobile trails out BlueMountain, Sabael, headquarters, and all town trails. This will need to be done again due to the large amounts of wind and water we have had.

We started work on the snowmobiles we have rebuilt two of the old alpires serviced the bearcat in the skidoo ordered many parts that will be needed for repair work on the sleds. Welded frames and repaired skis for the old Alpine's stripped down the machines that were remaining and took to transfer site.

Installed both snowblowers and cabs on the John Deere 318 tractors for snow removal on the rink. Blew the rink off for the first time this season.

We installed new lights on the skating rink to replace some of the ones that have gone bad and we went through a pool table that was donated the town and leveled and resurfaced the ball return. Built a table top and varnished to cover the pool table when it was not in use. Cleaned the leaves off of the skating rink and resurfaced some of the panels that were broken.

Put up banners and signs for the country Christmas tour took them down after the event was over.

Cleaned the Ski Hut put the tables back in and performed general maintenance after the event was over.

Went to Aaron Gadways and cut a Christmas tree that he had donated for the town put the tree up in the mini park, decorated, and ran power cords for the tree lighting ceremony on Friday. Put up decorations at the Town hall with Vonnice .

Went to tractor supply bought a new fuel tank for the back of the black Chevy pick up and installed the fuel tank.

Fixed a broken toilet at Byron Park and a leaking sink faucet. Picked up two of the large chairs and stored them in the pavilion at Byron Park.

Fixed a sink faucet at the senior meal site fixed a toilet at the senior meal site and replaced some lights . Country branches at the health center above the walkway main entrance , brought them to the Ski Hut put them in our stump dump along with the highways brush ,pushed the brush pile off and leveled out in preparation for winter plowing.

Fixed too light fixtures at the ski hut, replaced ballasts and serviced the air filter elements on the furnace.
