

PARKS AND REC. MONTHLY REPORT

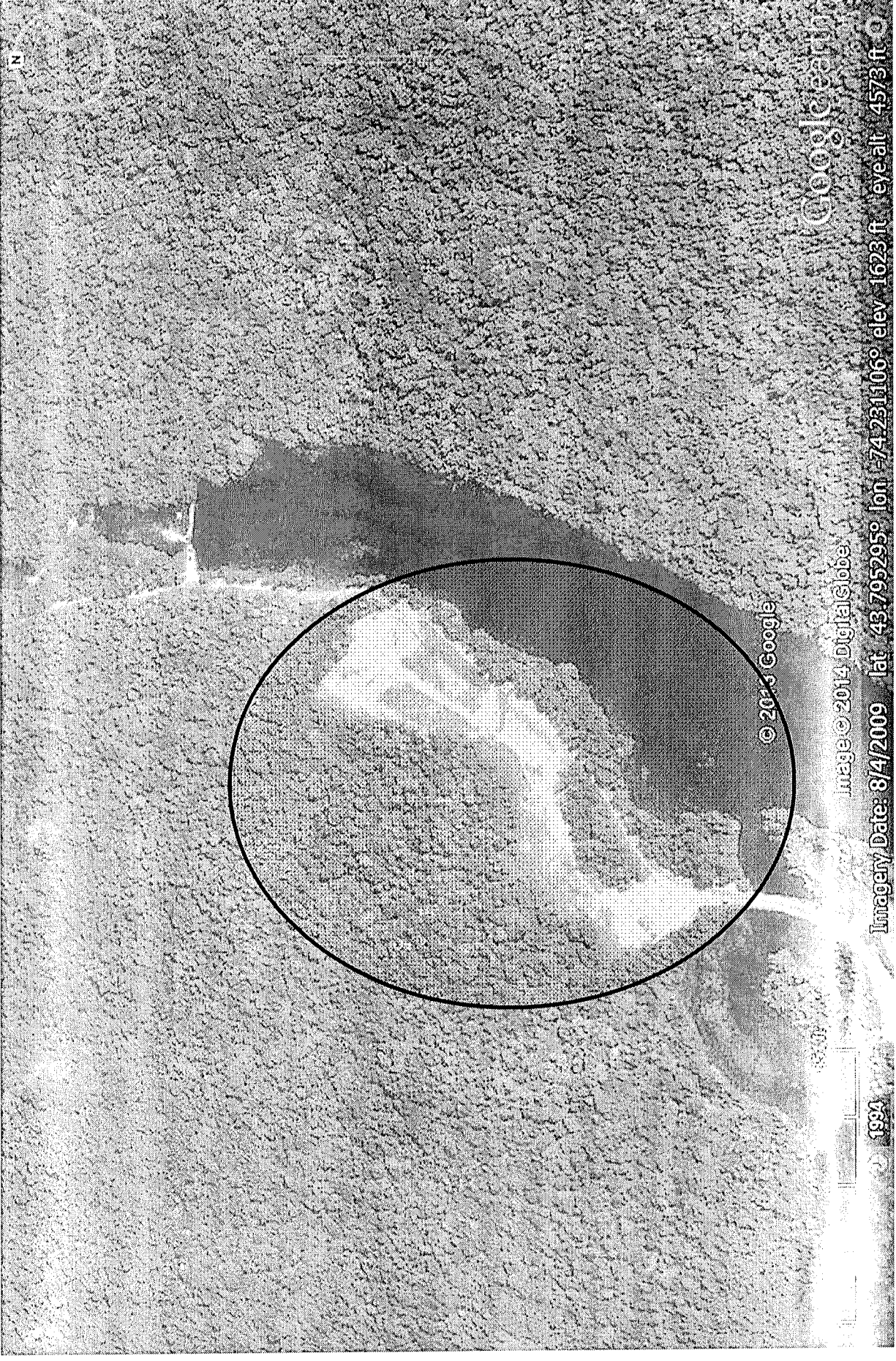
