

# **Town of Indian Lake water and wastewater**

## **Report for December 2016**

Testing was completed at all plants daily.

Samples required by DEC and DOH were submitted to the lab.

Koester Associates Inc. came for a meeting about the new U.V. units that are to be installed in the addition of the sewer plant next spring.


We have been working on the addition to the sewer plant. A steel beam had to be installed on the existing building to support the addition. Thank you to Greg Puterko for the welding we needed done. Since then we were able to get the walls framed up and sheeted, and our ledger board bolted to the new steel beams.

The boiler at the Indian Lake water plant went out and had to have a new fuel filter installed and the system bled for air.

The I.C.F. Home on Rt 30 is putting in a new sewer line in the spring, we dug up the sewer line alongside the home, as opposed to the sewer line in the State road, so they could see what they will need to tie into to it.

At the Abanakee dam project there was a breach in the coffer dam. Warren County Emergency Services, Barton's Mines, and Kubricky Construction had to be notified of the issue and updated hourly until the situation was under control.

There was a water main break on Wells Rd in Blue Mt. that had to be dug up and repaired.
